Ms. McQueary was appointed to the Global TransPark Board of Directors in August 2013 by Governor Pat McCrory.

Ms. McQueary is extensively involved in the Greensboro community and currently serves on the University of North Carolina, Greensboro Excellence Foundation Board, the Greensboro Historical Museum Inc.
